A graduate of the Moscow State Conservatory, Dr Evgeny Sorkin studied in Australia with Alice Waten at ANAM. After winning prizes in several international competitions, he began teaching at the Sydney Conservatorium in 2009, also working with young performers in the 'Rising Stars Program'.

His students include prize winners of the KPO NSW Secondary Schools Concerto competition, the National Youth Concerto Competition (2019), Animato International Violin Competition (2016), 4th New Talent British International Competition and many others. Former students have also won full scholarships to Juilliard and New England Conservatory of Music.

'My teaching philosophy is largely influenced by the Russian violin tradition where technical mastery serves artistic purpose. My central focus is to help students develop an understanding of how things work from the technical and artistic point of view and apply that knowledge to their performance. This includes developing creative and stylistically aware musicians, but also forming tension free and flexible movements that allow students to perform with ease and maintain an injury-free career in music.'
