### PROGRAM STRUCTURE

<b>UNITS AND LEVELS</b>	<p>You must complete a total of 96 units of courses, with:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>at least</i> 12 units and <i>no more than</i> 24 units of Level 1 courses</li> <li>• <i>at least</i> 72 units at Levels 2, 3 and 4</li> </ul>
<b>MUSIC (TEACHING AREA 1)</b>	<p>You must complete 42 units of Music courses. including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Level I courses to the value of 18 units</li> <li>• Level II courses to the value of 12 units</li> <li>• Level III courses to the value of 12 units</li> </ul>
<b>TEACHING AREA 2</b>	<p>You must complete 12 units of sequential electives in a different discipline to be eligible for a second teaching area. <i>You must choose a second teaching area from the <b>list below</b>.</i></p>
<b>EDUCATION</b>	<p>You must complete 42 units of Teaching Core courses, including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 18 units of Education Courses at level 1, 2 and 3 (6 units at each level)</li> <li>• 24 units of Education Courses at level 4, including 6 units of Curriculum &amp; Pedagogy courses.</li> </ul> <p>Prior to commencing 4th year you must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• successfully complete both the literacy and numeracy components of the LANTITE;</li> <li>• complete the requirements for the Bachelor of Music program.</li> </ul>

### PLEASE NOTE

- \*Music Education Performance courses must be taken in consecutive semesters/years. Any student who is not enrolled in a Music Education Performance course for one year or more will need to re-audition before recommencing
- ^Students can only enrol in Music Education Performance courses after attending an audition, usually held during orientation.
- You can undertake a **second teaching area** in the following areas: Chinese\*\*, Classroom Music, Economics, English, French\*\*, Geography, German\*\*, History, Indonesian\*\*, Instrumental Music, Italian\*\*, Japanese\*\*, Linguistics, Mathematics+, Media Studies, Modern Greek\*\*, Spanish\*\*  
\*\*Must seek advice from Faculty of Arts prior to enrolling  
+MATHS 3025 Professional Practice III cannot be presented towards the minor.
- All Teaching Curriculum & Pedagogy course lists can be found on the Faculty of Arts website.
- A course is usually worth 3 units, with some worth 6, 9 or 12. Information about all courses can be found in Course Planner.
- Some courses have restrictions and/or prerequisites (i.e. other courses you must complete first) - check Course Planner to make sure you meet these, if applicable.
- If you think you might like to undertake an internship or go on exchange, plan early in your degree so you don't miss out.

Enrolment Advice into Curriculum & Pedagogy courses for 2022:

## Some Curriculum and Pedagogy (C&P) courses are taught in Groups

In 2022, some of the C&P courses will be taught in groups. Please find the groups below.

Where C&P courses for both your teaching areas are taught in the same group, you will need to **enrol into each of your relevant courses, but only attend the one tutorial**.

*For example, if your teaching areas (TA) are Spanish and German, they will both be part of the Languages group and the following tutorials are available:*

- Tuesdays 5-8pm
- Thursdays 5-8pm

*You will need to enrol into **the same tutorial** for both courses. For example, if you choose the Tuesday tutorial for the Spanish TA you **ALSO** need to enrol into the Tuesday tutorial for the German TA.*

**Students who are eligible to study year 4, please ensure you enrol into both teaching areas, but only attend one tutorial per week (where your TA is in the same group).**

## Fill in a timetable Clash Resolution Form to enrol:

When you attempt to enrol in the tutorial at the same time, you will receive a timetable clash error, because our system is set up to avoid timetabling clashes. An Enrolment Request ID number will be generated in Access Adelaide. This number must be recorded on the form so the Arts Faculty Office can assess the enrolment request.
