PROGRAM STRUCTURE

UNITS AND LEVELS	 You must complete a total of 72 units of courses, with: at least 12 units and no more than 18 units of Level 1 courses (including 3 units from Arts Core Competency); at least 24 units of Level 3 courses.
CORE	You must complete 12 units of Arts Advanced core courses, including 3 units form the Arts Core Competency list.
ARTS MAJOR	A major is a sequence of courses in one discipline, totalling 24 units. Each major consists of courses at level 1, 2 and 3, and includes a capstone.
EMPLOYABILITY PATHWAY	To complete the employability pathway you must undertake courses to the value of 18 units, as detailed on page 2.
ELECTIVES	You must complete a total of 18 units of elective courses, with 9 units of broadening electives (courses from any discipline that is different to your major).

PLEASE NOTE

- In this degree you cannot present a major in the following areas: International Business, Management, and Marketing.
- All available majors and minors and their specific course/level requirements can be found on the Faculty of Arts website.
- A course is usually worth 3 units, with some worth 6, 9 or 12. Information about all courses can be found in Course Planner.
- Some courses have restrictions and/or prerequisites (i.e. other courses you must complete first) check Course Planner to make sure you meet these, if applicable.
- If you think you might like to undertake an internship or go on exchange, plan early in your degree so you don't miss out.
