

ESU (SA) - Peter Davies Memorial Prize in Creative Writing Prize Rules

Establishment

This Prize has been established by a donation to the University by the English-Speaking Union (SA Branch), in memory of a long-standing former President of the ESU (SA Branch) - Mr Peter Davies, who was also a past SA Coordinator of the Plain English Speaking Award (PESA).

The donor has agreed to support the prize at \$500 per year for 5 years until otherwise determined by the University after discussions with the donor. The first year of the prize being awarded will be 2017. The donor may renew for an additional 5 years following the completion of this first 5 years

Value

The value of the Prize will be \$500.00.

Eligibility

The prize is awarded by the University annually and on the following eligibility criteria: the prize will be awarded to students enrolled in a Creative Writing Course.

Selection of Candidate

The prize winner(s) will be selected by the Head of Department or his / her nominee and will be awarded to the student who demonstrates excellence in any area or genre of writing and who showed the most improvement during the course.

If there is no candidate of sufficient merit in any given year then the prize will not be awarded in that year.

If there is more than one candidate of equal merit, then the prize may be shared equally.
