

Goethe-Institut Prizes for German Studies Rules

Establishment

These Prizes have been established by a donation to the University by the Goethe-Institut Australien. The Goethe-Institut Australien, as the language and cultural institute of the Federal Republic of Germany, would like to acknowledge University of Adelaide students' achievements.

Value

The prize will consist of 4 books per year for five years until otherwise determined by the University after discussions with the donor. Each year the Head of German Studies will contact the Goethe-Institut to request the books to be posted to the Department of German Studies at The University of Adelaide.

Eligibility

Four prizes will be awarded by the University annually and on the following eligibility criteria:-

- Students enrolled in level I, level II or level III German Studies courses

Selection of Candidate

The Head of German Studies will award the four prizes as follows:-

- The top student who has completed German IA and IB Language in the given year;
- The top student who has completed German IIA and IIB Language in the given year;
- The top student who has completed German IIIA and IIIB Language in the given year;
- The top student who has completed Advanced German A and German B in the given year.

If there is no candidate of sufficient merit in any given year then the prize will not be awarded in that year.

Variations

The University may vary the rules from time to time in a manner consistent with the University's legal obligations and [policies](#).
