*Students should only consider Maths IA/B if they have completed the highest level of high school maths, have a*

*genuine love for maths, and are looking at take maths courses as electives at levels II and III. Extra Level I maths courses in addition to the selected combination, including Economics maths, are **NOT** permitted and will **NOT** count as Elective Courses.*

### Open Electives and Broadening Electives

Open (free choice) elective courses can be chosen from the Faculty of the Professions or any faculty in the University, where courses are not restricted.
