Introduction:

You may have noticed the changes introduced for the Undergraduate Business degrees. These changes were introduced after a review of our programs was conducted by the Adelaide Business School to better streamline our program offerings.

This being said, this doesn't reduce the quality of your current program – and we want to ensure that you understand what does and doesn't impact you.

What are the Changes?

- In order to streamline our offerings, you'll see that there is a reduced number of degree offerings.
- The study plans and program offerings look quite different, with the introduction of new courses and changes to the level of courses
- There are a number of courses that are being offered for the last time
- There will be a number of new courses

How do they affect me?

These changes will mostly impact students that commence their studies with us in 2021 or prior – as they'll need to follow the new program rules.

Important note: You follow the program rules and study plan for the year you commenced your degree. There may be a few minor impacts to your study plan – but we are also teaching out a number of our courses to ensure you can complete your studies as per your program rules.
