- Please limit your nomination to contributions made within the last 12 months.
- Please ensure that your statement is no more than 500 words.
- The deadline for nominations is 13th March 2024.

The awards are as follows:

1. Research Excellence Award

How have you demonstrated excellence in research in your HDR program so far?

Provide examples of how your research demonstrates originality, rigor, and impact.

Tell us what you did, why, and how it demonstrated excellence in research.

2. Education Excellence Award

How have you demonstrated excellence in helping provide education for your fellow students?

This can include lecturing, teaching, tutoring, volunteering as appropriate for your field. Provide examples of how your education practice has benefited your fellow students and the University.

Tell us what you did, why, and how it demonstrates your contribution to excellence in education.

3. Student Wellbeing Award

How have you contributed to the wellbeing of your fellow students? Provide examples of what you did, for whom, and what difference it made?

This can be through self-initiated or student-lead activities, community organizations, or outcomes directly related to your research - and is not limited to any one social, political, or economic issue.

Tell us what you did, why, who it helped, and how.

4. Community Contribution Award

How have you contributed to the wider University community?

This can be through self-initiated or student-lead activities, community organizations, or outcomes directly related to your research - and is not limited to any one social, political, or economic issue.

Tell us what you did, with whom. why, and how it helped.

5. Strategic Collaboration Award

How have you helped to build or strengthen relationships between the University and its partners? These can include other universities, as well as private or public industries.

Tell us what you did, why, and how it helped to strengthen collaboration between the University its partners.
